

# ERRATA

The following corrections are to be made in Volume 24-B:

On page 3, the statement that F. Taylor Ostrander “worked on Wall Street during the stock market crash of October 1929” is wrong. Ostrander worked on Wall Street only in July and August; in October he was taking Economics 1 from Walter B. Smith at Williams College.

On page 318, in the introduction to F. Taylor Ostrander’s letter of May 3, 1945, the correct name is Mrs. Liesel Ostrander; Lionel is wrong.

On page 320, “H\*Y\*P\*” refers to the Harvard, Yale, Princeton Club of Pittsburgh. “John” refers to John Toop, earlier an instructor of European History at Williams; killed in an automobile accident on the Autobahn in Germany. “Alex” refers to Alex Daspit formerly a Rhodes Scholar at Oxford from the University of Louisiana who later had a long career in the Foreign Service and AID.
